

## Privacy Policy in Windhunter Academy

The Company processes the personal data of the Delegates in compliance with required Polish security regulations, as well as it respects the law related. Personal data is processed by the Company in accordance with the Personal Data Protection Act only for marketing purposes.

The Company ensures the realization of the rights resulting from aforementioned Act, in particular the right to access own data, to correct them, and to object in the cases specified by the provisions of this Act.

In the case of the transfer of personal data and authorization process, it is performed using a secure protocol. The Company may send ordered information, promotional materials and offers on Delegate's e-mail address, after he agrees.

Personal data is used only for the purpose of concluding and realizing the Agreement. Personal data will be provided to third parties only if it is necessary for the realization of the Agreement, in particular when required by GWO (Global Wind Organisation) or for settlement purposes.

Any person, who has given his / her consent to the use and transfer of personal data, has the right to withdraw previously given consent at any time and with an appropriate effect in the future.
